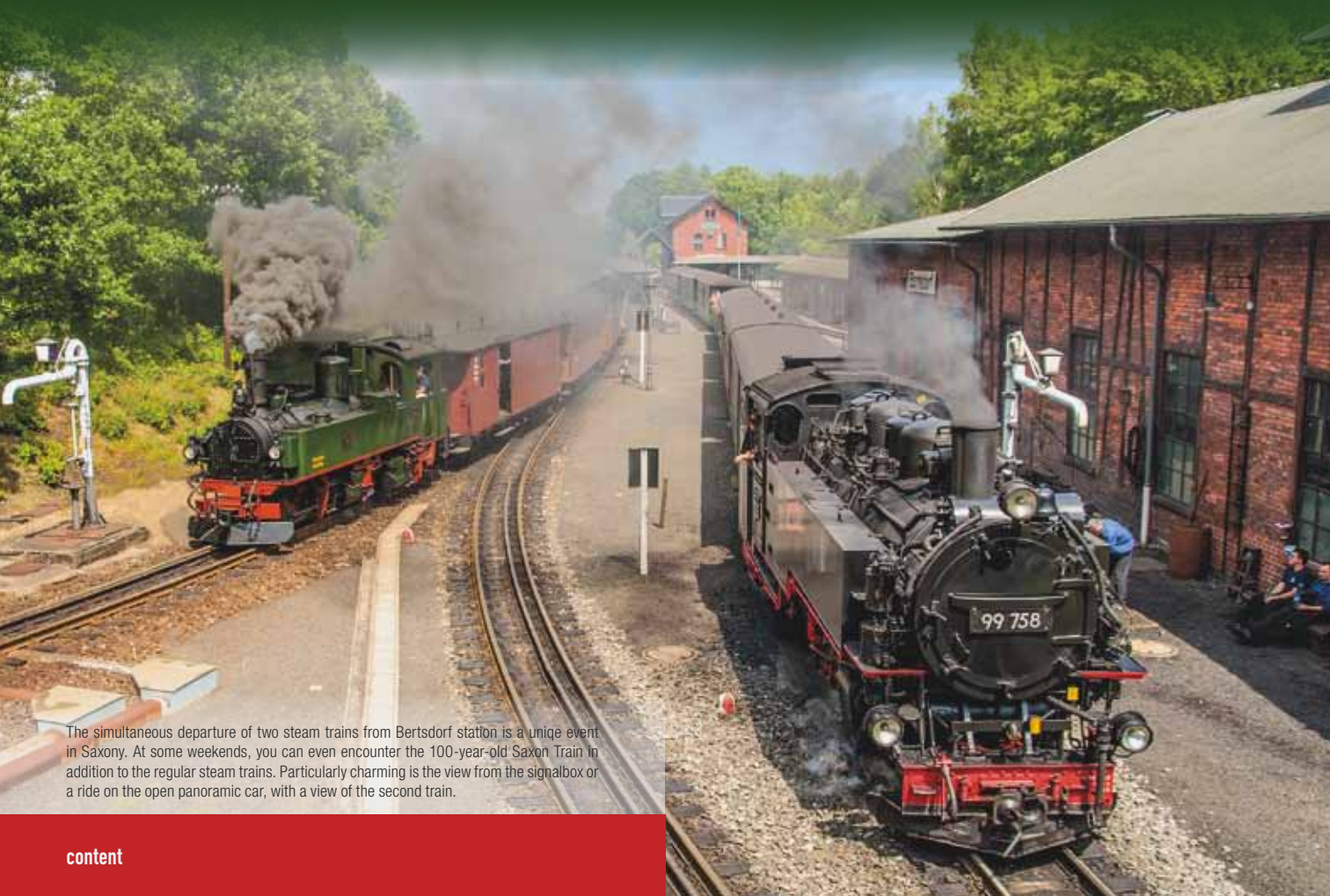

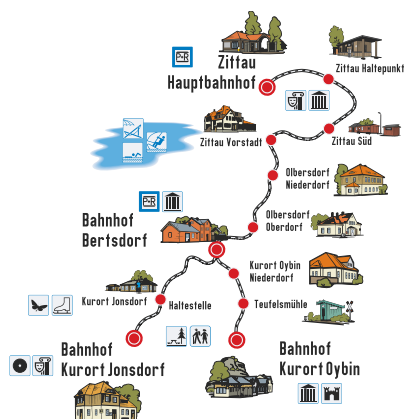

## Excursion and hiking destinations along the route

The train stations of the Zittau Narrow-Gauge Railway are popular starting points for hikes into the Zittau Mountains.

**Hike** from Jonsdorf to Oybin: 3.7 miles (6 km) (and back on the Narrow-Gauge Railway)

**Zittau:** Lenten viel, hisoric Old Town, theater

**Olbersdorf:** short hiking trail around the lake, educational mining trail

**Bertsdorf train station:** educational steam train trail to Oybin, museum railway station in Bertsdorf

**Stop at Teufelsmühle (Devil's Mill):** Töpfer (Potter), Ameisen (Ants) and Pferde (Horses) mountains

**Oybin health resort:** Fuchskanzel viewpoint, castle and monastery ruins, high forest

**Jonsdorf health resort stop:** Weißer Stein rock formation, Cultural Trail Bleichkolonie (Bleaching Colony), Butterfly House, leisure hall with ice rink

**Jonsdorf health resort:** Mühlsteinbrüche (Millstone Pits), Nonnenfelsen (Nun's Rock) and Gondelteich (Gondola Lake)

The panoramic train is stopping at Jonsberg mountain exactly at the blue hour. If you like taking pictures, there is enough time for capturing that special moment. Daily steam service to the mountains and open panoramic cars running in nice weather

- Using standard steam locomotives or Einheitslokomotiven Class Altbau-VII K, we offer our simultaneous departures from Bertsdorf station daily in the high season in collaboration with the Saxon-Upper Lusatian Railway Company (Sächsisch-Oberlausitzer Eisenbahngesellschaft or SOEG).
- During the high season, trains always have a dining car; while in the low season, there is a dining car from Friday through Sunday (from Monday through Thursday, only upon advance reservation). (picture above)
- All steam trains (except the Saxon and Reichsbahn trains) operate open panoramic cars daily from May to October in nice weather. (picture on the right)
- The barrier-free cars provided with hydraulic lifts are operated daily in both regular trains (not in the Saxon train, Reichsbahn train and the railcar).







**Time Travel Train No. 1: travelling just like in 1915  
on the 100-year-old Saxon train**

The Saxon train hauled by a Class IV K locomotive – probably the most important Saxon locomotive type – will take you back to the heyday of narrow-gauge railways: the time of the Royal Saxon State Railways. The historic train set has third- and fourth-class cars furnished with wooden chairs. The train operates at **every second and fourth weekend (only Saturday and Sunday) from May to October**. The train operates at 8:41 a.m. from Zittau, commuting between the health resorts of Oybin and Jonsdorf via Bertsdorf.

**Zittau VT 137 322 Triebwagen (Rail Car) with original trailer car**

After not having been used for over 40 years, the Zittau VT 137 322 Triebwagen built in 1937 was put back into operation by the SOEG in August 2007, thus making it possible to experience the post-war development of the Reichsbahn railway. In 2016, the rail car was supplemented with the last trailer car preserved in its original state, and it now operates **every first and third Sunday between May and October**. The train runs according to the diesel timetable: every Saturday, and every second and fourth Sunday from May to October. In the event of failure of a steam locomotive, the 199 018 L45H diesel locomotive will be used.

IK Steam Locomotive – Travelling just like in 1900

The IK train represents the early years of narrow-gauge railways in Saxony, illustrating the remarkable achievements of Saxon engineers over 125 years ago. For the locomotive built in 2009 based on historical model, a historically fitting two-axle train was built in an unparalleled joint venture seven years later, in August 2016.

If you visit us on one of our special operating days, you can travel on the last preserved double carriage or learn what the legendary Bänkelwagen freight train is all about. Upon request, the IK train can be operated on any 750 mm (2 ft 5 1/2 in) narrow-gauge lines – also bookable as a private photo train.

# HISTORIK MOBIL Railway Festival

## 3 to 5 August 2018

Already for the 12th time, the HISTORIK MOBIL festival perfectly combines heritage experiences on the rails of the Zittau Narrow-Gauge Railway and on the roads of the Zittau Mountains. The Jolly Jumper party band will provide the musical accompaniment, and the grand display of fireworks will take place next to Bertsdorf station. During the following two days, there will be dense rail traffic on all branch lines of the Zittau Narrow-Gauge Railway. Furthermore, we recommend you visit the public festival at Bertsdorf station featuring the open museum station, several merchants and associations, with nice musical accompaniment.



The Jonsdorf Oldtimertage (vintage car days) present road vehicles, Bulldogs, trucks and fire engines at the station and next to the town hall in the health resort of Jonsdorf. Once again, numerous exceptional vehicles from the history of engines will take part in the demonstration and regularity race of the Classic Cup held by the ADMV (General German Motor Sport Association) during the 95th Lückendorf mountain race.

- Inauguration of the Oybin children's railway station as an adventure playground
- Initial operation of the open-top panoramic car built for the East German Reichsbahn train

Let yourself be taken back to a bygone era. Enjoy a ride on a narrow-gauge train departing from Zittau at 10:17 a.m. or from Jonsdorf at 10:05 a.m. and going to Oybin. You will be accompanied by a maid or menial to travel back to medieval times at the castle and monastery complex. The lord of the castle or his minions will let you in, offering a guided adventure tour including information about weaponry and a knightly wine tasting in the vaults of the castle and monastery ruins.
